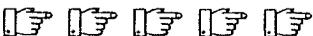
We will also be looking at programs you may write with a view to distributing them both here and overseas if they are good enough.

However, due to the publishers setting very high standards, STOS is for all intents and purposes bug free, and we can expect a similar attention to detail and speedy fixing for AMOS.
